NEW ROCHELLE ARPA FAQs

What is ARPA funding?

The **American Rescue Plan Act of 2021** (“ARPA”) signed into law on March 11, 2021, provides **\$350 billion** in emergency funding for state, local, territorial, and Tribal governments to remedy the disparity between rising costs and falling revenues. The City of New Rochelle will receive **\$37million** in two payments, creating a historic opportunity to achieve fiscally responsible objectives that will shape New Rochelle’s future. Who is eligible to apply?

Businesses and **Non for Profit organizations** that endured negative economic impacts due to COVID and/or provide services to disproportionately impacted communities. **Businesses may also apply for hazard pay** for their employees.

How will an application be reviewed will funds be given out on a first-come, first-served basis?

All applications who apply for the first tranche of funding will be considered & reviewed by a committee. There will be two tranches. Currently, only the first tranche’s funding has been announced. The second round of funding is anticipated to arrive in Spring/Summer 2022 and the New Rochelle City Council will determine how that second tranche will be spent.

When is the deadline?

Friday, July 15, 2022
